11 Pouilly Fuisse , Les Ancolin, Loron 2014 <i>The wines from the chalky soil of this well-known appellation in the Mâconnaise are in great demand for their classic, fuller style.</i>	59
12 Muscadet Sevre & Maine, Sur Lie, La Doussiniere 2016 <i>A bone-dry white wine from Muscadet grape grown in Western Loire Valley, close to the city of Nantes</i>	33
13 Sancerre Les Collinettes 2014/16 <i>A splendid wine that is stylish and crisp, with the classic gooseberry character well balanced by hints of honey, caramel and grapefruit. Made by one of the Loire's most championed producers this wine is regularly acclaimed and awarded.</i>	49
14 Pouilly Fume , La Ralotte, Adrien Marechal 2015 <i>Classic unoaked Sauvignon Blanc from the village of Pouilly-sur-Loire, just about in the centre of France. Shows the typical aromatic fruit and fresh cut herb character,backed with a steely, dry finish.</i>	49

18 Piesporter Michelsberg, J Brader NV <i>Light, elegant aromas of ripe nectarine mixed with a touch of fresh wildflowers; from the village of Piesport in the heart of the Mosel region.</i>	27
19 Riesling Pinot Blanc 2015 <i>A fresh and fruity wine that is light in style.It is fine mineral tonesare combined with apple and stone fruits.</i>	29
ITALY	
21 Gavi di Gavi, Enrico Serafino <i>The Cortese grapes for this wine came from the best vineyards around the town of Gavi to the north of Genova. Unoaked, the wine spends a little time on its lees to develop a richer mouth-feel. Pale straw-yellow, floral and citrus aromas, with a mineraly, dry palate.</i>	31
AUSTRALIA	
30 Caves Road Classic White Sémillon-Sauvignon Blanc, Margaret River <i>Fruit from the length of the Margaret River region is sourced for this wine, combining the richer flavours of the warmer north with the racy acidity of the grapes grown in the south of the region; here the grapes are cooled by the Southern Ocean breezes as they ripen. This wine is a blend of 65% Semillon and 35% Sauvignon Blanc; the grapes being picked in the cool of the morning in separate parcels, in the early part of the vintage cycle. The fruit was then gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel to retain the fruit's freshness. The refreshing palate shows Semillon's strong citrus aromatics and passion fruit and blackcurrant flavours from the Sauvignon Blanc.</i>	27
31 Berri Estates, Unoaked Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia 2014/16 <i>The grapes for this fresh, lemony Chardonnay are fermented and matured in stainless steel with no oak contact, the aim being to retain the fresh yet ripe acidity and weight of the classic Chardonnay</i>	28
32 Bay of Fires Pinot Gris, Tasmania, Australia 2016 <i>Pinot Gris from the East Coast, Derwent Valley and Coal River Valley growing areas of Tasmania. This is a pale straw-yellow coloured wine that shows enticing aromas of spicy pear and rosewater. The off-dry palate features characters of melon and peach, while a smooth, supple mouth-feel is derived from allowing certain parcels of fruit to undergo a wild-yeast fermentation before being blended with the controlled ferments. The result is a wine which is full and complex with a crisp, refreshing acidity</i>	33
SOUTH AFRICA	
35 Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch 2015 <i>Hand-harvested premium quality grapes from some of the oldest vines on the estate are used to produce this elegant, full-bodied wine. The initial fermentation is in stainless steel before being transferred to French oak barrels, a third new, the rest second or third fill</i>	27
36 Flagstone Word of Mouth Viognier, Western Cape26 <i>The grapes for this Viognier come from the cool-climate regions of Elgin and Elim, known for producing high quality fruit. Aromas of fresh, ripe watermelon and juicy peach are encased in a delicate hint of spice. Medium-bodied but with a richness to the palate, common to Viognier, the wine finishes fresh, again with hints of Oriental spice.</i>	

NEW ZEALAND

- 40 Vidal Marlborough Riesling 2014/15 38
New Zealand Rieslings are rapidly gaining reputation. Sourced from three vineyards in the premium care of Awatere Valley gives the wine an intense tropical fruit aromas and flavours, with a delicious just off dry finish
- 41 Vidal Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2016/17 45
Selected from the Awatere and Wairau Valleys in Marlborough, New Zealand's premier Sauvignon growing region. Classic gooseberry and passion fruit aromas mingle with a crisp grassy flavour.

CHILE

- 46 Los Romeros Chardonnay, Central Valley 2015 27
Appealingly fresh and fruity unoaked Chardonnay; shows plenty of tropical fruit aromas with citrus and stone-fruit flavours on the finish.

ARGENTINA

- 50 Arido Chardonnay, Mendoza 26
Chardonnay appreciates a cool-climate vineyard and does well at altitude in the Mendoza region. Golden-yellow with greenish tints, it presents ripe peach, pear and apricot fruit on the nose; the palate reflects these fruits with a touch of sweetness on the finish.

USA

- 52 Lavender Hill Chardonnay, California 25
Juicy, lightly oaked Chardonnay with a good intensity of flavours; it shows peach, pineapple and melon with a touch of spice.

ROSÉ WINE

- 55 Rare Vineyards Cinsault Vieilles Vignes, France 2015 32
Made from 100% Cinsault, cool fermented and bottled early to capture all the fresh summer fruit flavours, this wine shows notes of raspberry and cherry on a refreshing palate.
- 56 Kleine Zalze Gamay Noir, Coastal Region, South Africa 2016 32
Gamay, the black grape of Beaujolais, is ideally suited for producing roses with its tendency to produce light, red fruit flavoured wines. It is bursting with strawberry and dark cherry on the palate, and is distinctly off dry.
- 57 Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini 2014/16 29
Pinot Grigio is neither dark or light skinned (actually somewhere in between) as such it lends itself well to the production of pink wines. Just off-dry with delicious peach and strawberry flavours this fashionable combination of colour and grape is a good choice for many wine lists.

RED WINE

- 60 Château Lyonnat, Lussac-Saint-Émilion 37
This wine is a blend of 85% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Cabernet Franc. Deep garnet with a warm spiced bread and red fruit character; powerful, yet supple; with vanilla aromas on the finish.
- 61 Château de Camarsac, Thierry Lurton 2012/14 36
The wine is vinified and aged in stainless steel with the aim of making a rich, smooth and fruity wine which can be appreciated from an early age.
- 64 Beaujolais Village Thorin 2015 39
Selected from villages in the hillier central and Haut-Beaujolais. The wine has a typical Beaujolais character but with more depth and fruit.

<p>Château de Fleurie de Bellevue 2014</p> <p><i>This 19th-century chateau was purchased by Loron et Fils in 2009 and a new winery was built to make wine, from the 11 hectares of vineyards in Fleurie and Morgan they own, under the supervision of Jean-Pierre Rodet and Claire Forestier. The wine is bright, fresh and with delicious strawberry aromas.</i></p>

<p>Côtes du Rhône, La Denteliere 2015</p> <p><i>Soft and peppery, an attractive blend using 70% Grenache with some Syrah, and Mourvedre, sourced mainly from the Vaucluse and Gard district, to give a typically warm, ripe-flavoured wine.</i></p>

<p>Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir 2016</p> <p><i>The Pinot Noir grapes come from vineyards located in South West Languedoc Roussillon, close to the Pyrenees mountains, about 30% of the blend is aged in French Oak giving a smooth, velvety palate showing cherry and blueberry flavour.</i></p>

<p>Côtes du Beaune-Villages, Paul Deloux 2013</p> <p><i>a well balanced wine with youthful Pinot Noir fruit from a blend of selected parcels of wine from the 16 lesser known villages of the Côte de Beaune to give a deep colour, fresh fruit expression and good length and balance</i></p>

<p>Chianti, Ruffino 2014/15</p> <p><i>This wine is made exclusively of Sangiovese, it shows floral and fruity notes that lead towards spicy scents of white pepper and hazlenuts.</i></p>

<p>Montepulciano D'Abruzzo Valle Reale 2012/16</p> <p><i>Ruby-red; the nose shows plum and cherry with notes of violet; dry, soft but well structured with a pleasant long lasting finish of dried fruits and toasted hazlenut.</i></p>

<p>Marqués de Morano Rioja Crianza</p> <p><i>Made from Tempranillo and Mazuelo grapes which are matured for at least a year in cask followed by at least a year in bottle to give that classic smooth oaky taste.</i></p>

<p>Don Jacobo Rioja Reserva 2009/10</p> <p><i>A very fine Rioja 95% Tempranillo, plus Garnacha and Mazuelo that spends 18 months in oak barrels in cool cellars and bottled for two more years. Traditional in style with the developed fruit and spice character expected of a mature Rioja.</i></p>

<p>Bay of Fires Pinot Noir, Tasmania</p> <p><i>Bright red in colour, this wine displays complex aromas of sweet ripe red berry fruit alongside star anise, cinnamon spice and floral nuances. Although elegant and supple, the wine shows remarkable power, intensity and length on the palate; this is framed by ripe, moderate tannins and a sweet blueberry fruit character which is complemented by spice notes.</i></p>

<p>Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Cabernet Sauvignon, Stellenbosch 2017</p> <p><i>From 30-year-old vines on the original Kleine Zalze farm. Traditional fermentation and long maceration for maximum colour and fruit extraction. Aged 12 months in small French oak barrels. The quality of the premium grapes used shines through with typical Cabernet flavours such as blackcurrant, cassis and warm cedar notes.</i></p>

<p>Vidal Pinot Noir Reserva, Hawkes Bay 2014/15</p> <p><i>The maritime climate of New Zealand is perfect for Pinot Noir. Outstanding wine using selected fruits from newly planted vineyard near Mareakakaho, stored for 10 months in French oak barrels, giving a sweet raspberry taste.</i></p>

<p>Vidal Syrah, Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon 2011</p> <p><i>This classic blend displays aromas of red fruits and spice. With flavours of plum, blackcurrant and cedar, the smooth finish on the palate is supported by supple, approachable tannins. An excellent partner for grilled meats.</i></p>	

CHILE

- 86 Errázuriz 1870 Mapuche Block Cabernet Sauvignon, Aconcagua Valley 26

Typical Chilean Cabernet Sauvignon showing plenty of blackcurrant and bramble fruit flavours on a well-structured palate. A third of the wine is aged for about six months in a mixture of French & American oak and 15% is Shiraz, both of which add depth and complexity.

ARGENTINA

- 89 Arido Malbec, Mendoza 2017 27

Made from 100% Malbec grapes that are harvested by hand from vineyards planted on well-drained, sandy-loam soils. Here at altitude the nights are very cold and the ripening season long. Medium ruby-red, the nose shows red fruits and notes of dried fig the palate is fruit led and fresh.

USA

- 90 Rugged Ridge Merlot, California 28

Ripe black plum with notes of blueberry on a light and juicy finish.
